

Rigaku–ICTAC Promising Researcher Award 2026

Call for Nominations

1. Background and Purpose

The **Rigaku–ICTAC Promising Researcher Award**, established in 2022, is an annual distinction recognizing outstanding early-career researchers who have made notable contributions to the field of thermal analysis and calorimetry. The award reflects ICTAC's commitment to nurturing emerging scientific talent and strengthening the future of the discipline.

The award will be presented at a conference hosted by an ICTAC-affiliated society. In 2026, it will be conferred during the **14th European Symposium on Thermal Analysis and Calorimetry (ESTAC 14)**, scheduled for **15–18 September 2026 in Split, Croatia**.

The award is intended not only to recognize excellence but also to provide a platform for young researchers to present their work to an international audience.

2. Award Benefits

The recipient of the award will receive:

- A commemorative plaque
 - A financial grant of **USD 1500** to support travel and living expenses
 - An opportunity to present their research at ESTAC 14

3. Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must:

- Be active researchers in the field of thermal analysis and calorimetry
 - Be **under 35 years of age as of 31 December 2025**
 - Be nominated through an ICTAC-affiliated society

4. Nomination Process

Nominations must be submitted by the President of an ICTAC-affiliated society on behalf of its Council.

Each affiliated society is permitted to submit **only one nomination**.

The nomination package must include:

1. A formal **letter of nomination** from the President of the Affiliate Society
 2. A **curriculum vitae** of the candidate
 3. A **list of publications**
 4. A **one-page abstract** of the paper the candidate intends to present at ESTAC 14
